

City of Antioch Disabled Parking Policy and Application Process

To have a disabled parking space installed in front of your residence the following criteria must be met and the request processed:

- The resident must not have any accessible off-street parking available (e.g. a residential driveway).
- Special circumstances will be considered, (e.g., the driveway or garage may not be accessible to load and unload a disabled person due to a steep slope).
- The resident must have a current official document from the Department of Motor Vehicles stating they are eligible to carry the disabled parking placard or license plate.
- The resident and the property owner must make a written request to the City Traffic Engineer indicating why there is a need for the parking space. Requests may be mailed to P.O. Box 5007 Antioch, CA 94531-5007 or faxed to (925) 779-6180.

Other important considerations:

- The resident should be aware that this is a public parking space and that anyone holding a disabled placard or license plate can park in the space.
- Disabled parking spaces are not exempt from street sweeping and all applicable federal, state and local laws.
- Disabled spaces will not be installed to act as loading zones for residents. The resident must drive a vehicle that will utilize the space.
- Once the disabled resident vacates the property or the space is no longer deemed necessary, the resident and the property owner are to make written request to have the space removed.
