

Registrant Appointment Procedure

- Registrants must now contact the Antioch Police Department to arrange for their mandated processing by either calling **925-779-6921** or by e-mailing **antiochregistrants@ci.antioch.ca.us**.
- Appointments will be available from **Monday thru Friday at 9:00am, 10:00am, 7:00pm & 8:00pm.**

Registration Requirements Overview for PC290, HS11590, PC457.1 and Gang.

PC290 (Sexual Assault) Registrants

Must register within 5 working days from:

1. Coming into California
2. Released from incarceration
3. Released on probation

Must register within 5 working days, if previously registered upon release from incarceration that lasted 30 or more days.

Must annually update registration within 5 working days before or after birthday.

Must register within 5 working days, upon coming into or changing residences.

Must register within 5 working days, upon becoming transient.

Must register once every 30 days, if transient.

Must register no less than once every 90 days if a sexually violent predator.

Must register within 5 working days if residing at additional residences and must inform in person within 5 working days when no longer living at a residence.

Must inform in person within 5 working days, if changes name.

(See CJIS form 8120S for inclusive registration requirements)

HS11590 (Narcotics) Registrants

Registration requirement terminates 5 years after discharge from prison/jail or expiration of probation/parole.

Must register within 30 days of moving into county or city.

Must inform in writing within 10 working days upon changing location of residence.

(See CJIS form 8102N for inclusive registration requirements)

PC457.1 (Arson) Registrants

Must register within 14 working days upon coming into any city or county in which they will establish residency.

Must inform in writing within 10 working days of a change of address

(See CJIS form 8102A for inclusive registration requirements)

Gangs

All initial gang registration requests will be forward to the Lieutenant in charge of the Antioch Police Department's Gang Unit. The Gang Unit will then arrange the required appointment.

Must inform within 10 days in writing change of address
