Description

- In partnership with The Home Depot, Gifts In Kind International will launch a local store product donation program in 2008
- Each Home Depot store will be matched with one or more local charity in this year-round product donation program
- Each charity is responsible for picking up the donations at the store on a weekly basis
- Products to be donated include end-of-season, returns and buy-backs—all in good usable condition

Description

- Products not included in the initial program include paints, Hazmat, ladders and chain saws
- Each charity is expected to receive \$50,000 - \$75,000 in products annually, or 2-3 pallets each week.



Program

- Charities 501c3 engage in home and shelter rehab, building and maintenance are eligible for the program
- Community charities supplying building and home improvement material to the poor and needy are also eligible
- Eligible charities must register and be vetted by Gifts In Kind International
- Charities must abide by Federal Tax Code 170e by not selling, auctioning or using the products other than helping the poor & needy. Vetting/registration fee is \$150 annually
- Each participating charity must also pay \$500 annually in support of GIKI's program management



The Works

- Once a week, the charity will receive email notification from GIKI attached with the inventory list from the assigned store ready for the pick-up
- The participating charity has 48-hours to pick-up the products from the store—due to limitation of store space
- Charity's failure to pick-up within the time frame will incur a shipping expense of \$250-\$300 to ship the products to the charity. Two failures to pick-up donations on time will eliminate the charity's eligibility in the program
- Charity must provide a dock-height truck for every pick-up. Products will be shrink-wrapped and palletized



Qualification

- Appropriate Charity: A qualified and legitimate 501 (c)(3) charity that engages in on-going & year-round community home and shelter programs:
 - Renovation of elder homes
 - Renovation or provider of low income housing
 - Community tool chest for low income homes or to other nonprofits
- Charities that have the capacity to pick up (dock-height truck) and use the selection and volume of products
- Charities committed to reporting and accountability
- Charity within a 40-minute drive-time from each store location



Matching Options

- HD stores classified by sales volume
 - Mega stores: \$75 million plus
 - Large stores: \$45-74 million
 - Medium stores: \$25-44 million
 - Small or new stores: Under \$25 million
- Large and mega stores will be matched with more than one charity per location. Some mega stores may have up to three charities matched
- Remote location stores may have multiple small charities matched

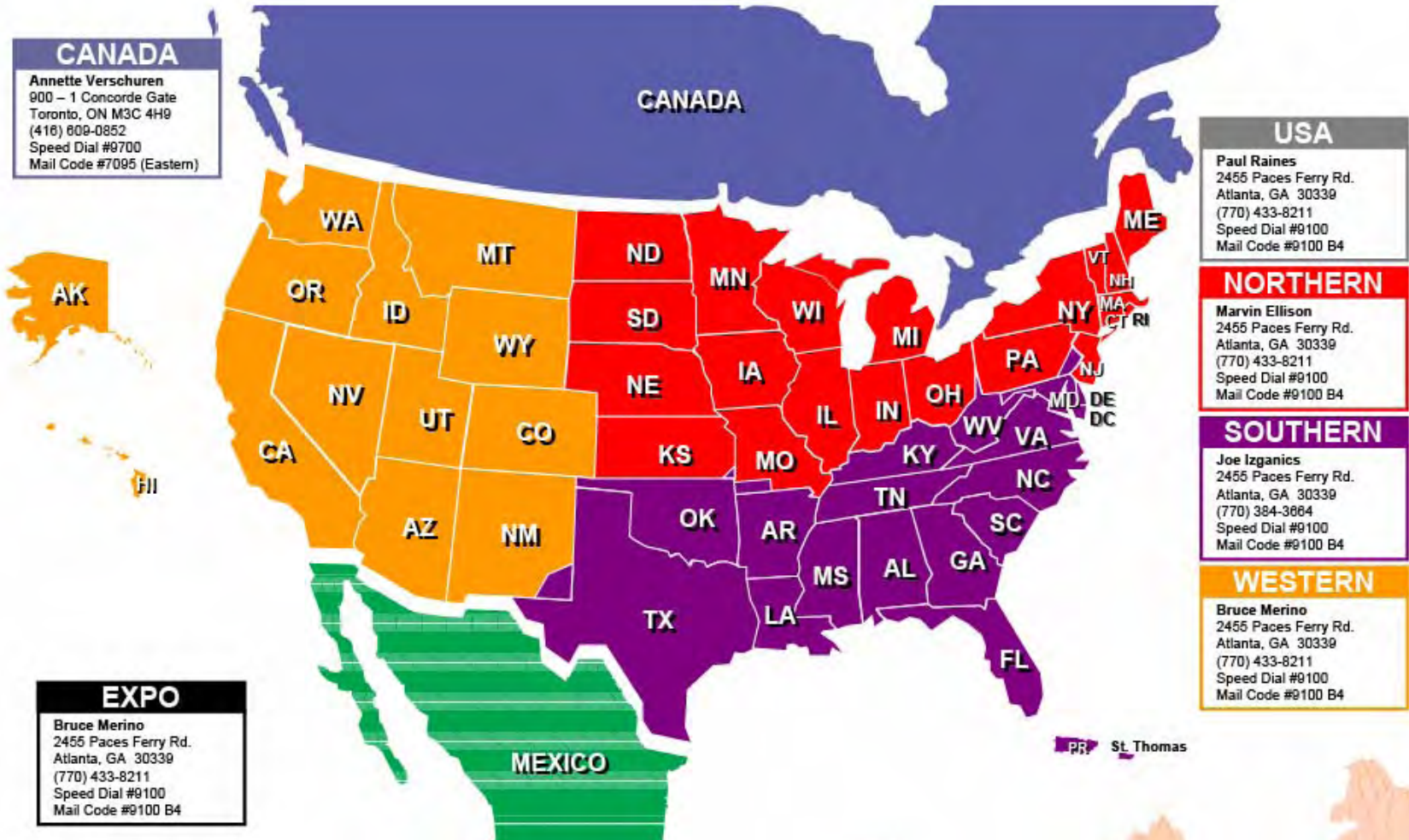
