

LOCAL RECYCLING OPTIONS
FOR
TELEVISIONS AND COMPUTER MONITORS

Following is a select list of local opportunities to properly dispose of your unwanted televisions and computer monitors. Remember, it is illegal to dispose of cathode ray tubes ("CRTs" include televisions and monitors) with your household garbage and recyclables. For additional information, refer to the resources printed on the pamphlet or contact your local recycling agency.

On-Call Curbside Collection:

Computer monitors and televisions can be collected at your curb for a fee, by appointment.

- **Pittsburg** residents call: Pittsburg Disposal (925) 432-6262
- **Antioch, Bay Point, Clayton, Danville, Lafayette, Moraga, Orinda, Walnut Creek, and Unincorporated Central County** residents call: Pleasant Hill Bayshore Disposal, (925) 603-1144
- **Brentwood** residents call: Utility Billing Dept. (925) 516-5415 to schedule an appointment. The fee is \$23.53 per CRT.
- **Oakley and Far East Unincorporated County** residents call: (925) 757-7660

Drop-Off Locations:

We recommend that you call before you haul to confirm location, hours, charges and acceptable materials.

- **Contra Costa Waste Service Recycling Center & Transfer Station, Pittsburg, (925) 473-0180:** Accepts all types of electronic products for recycling for a fee. Please call first.

Drop-Off Locations (continued):

- **Computer Renaissance, Pleasant Hill, (925) 827-1200:** Buys, sells, trades and services used and new computer equipment. Items must be operable. Pick-up service available.
- **Contra Costa Transfer Station & Recovery Station, Martinez, (925) 313-8900:** Accepts working and non-working computers, monitors and televisions for recycling for \$25. Other computer-related equipment is accepted for \$5. Please call first.
- **Second Chance, Alamo, (925) 820-6525:** Accepts working televisions and VCRs.
- **Davis Street Transfer Station & Recycling Park, San Leandro, (510) 638-2303:** Accepts all types of electronic products for recycling for a fee.
- **Alameda County Computer Resource Center, Oakland, (510) 434-1325:** Non-profit computer recycling organization accepts working and non-working mainframes (\$5), monitors (\$10), televisions (\$10; consoles are \$30) and, copiers (\$50).
